School Payment Policy

1. Tuition and Other Optional Fees

Tuition Payment

- Tuition fees must be paid by (a) cash or (b) bank transfer in full by the due date stated on the invoice.
- Tuition for students who start after the term has begun will be **prorated from their actual start date**.
- All payments are **non-refundable** and **non-transferable** unless stated under the Withdrawal Policy.
- New students from Blueberries to Raspberries classes are allowed an option to do trial class either half day or full day for 5 study days. The trial period is free from any commitment to pay. If the parents choose to enroll the students, they will have to pay from the first starting date of trial. However, if the parents do not enroll or the school does not admit the student by the fifth day, there will not be any tuition charge.
- Cross academic year payment is not permitted.

Meals

- Optional meal service includes:
 - **Breakfast:** \$85 per term
 - **Lunch:** \$150 per term
 - **Afternoon Snack:** \$50 per term
- Meals are only available from a **monthly (20 study days) to annual basis**; the caterer does not accept payments for shorter periods. Payment less than one month is only applicable to new students who join trial classes.
- Payment for student meals must be made at least one working day prior to the start of meal provision.

Transportation

- Available for **Campus 3 students** only.
- A **30% discount** is offered until the end of AY 2025-2026.
- Availability of providing transportation service is considered case by case depending on the actual number of signs up and addresses.

Field Trips

- One field trip is organized each term, appropriate to students' age groups.
- Fees vary based on venue and transport, typically **\$5–\$20 per trip**.

Other Optional Fess

- **School T-shirt:** \$6 each.
- **Student Pickup Cards:** Two cards are provided free upon registration. Additional cards cost \$5 each.

2. Late Payment Policy

- **Due Dates:** All invoices must be paid **on or before the due date** indicated.
- **Late Fees:**
 - A **\$5 late fee per school day** will be charged after the due date.
 - If a late payment exceeds 10 school days, students will not be permitted to attend school until all outstanding fees have been paid.
 - To avoid late fees, parents are encouraged to contact the school before the due date to propose a date for late payment that will require authorization from the school management.

3. Withdrawal and Refund Policy

Refunds are determined based on the timing of withdrawal:

Withdrawal Date	Refund Eligibility
30+ days before start date	90% refund
Less than 30 days before start date	50% refund
On or after start date	No refund

Refund above applies to tuition payment only. For meal and transportation services, parents will receive an unused amount after the last day of services provided.

4. Discount Policy

- **Sibling Discount:**
 - 5% discount on tuition for the second
 - 10% discount on tuition for the third and subsequent child enrolled.

5. Force Majeure Clause

In the event of extraordinary circumstances beyond the school's control (including but not limited to natural disasters, pandemics, strikes, war, or government orders), the following applies:

- The school will notify parents in writing of the nature and extent of the disruption.
- If the school has taken reasonable steps to minimize the impact, it will **not be held liable for any interruption in service, and no refunds will be issued.**
- The school will make every effort to continue educational services, including offering **online learning**, where appropriate.
